

## Growth within the Pipes & Fittings Market

The performance of the UK pipes and fittings market is and has always been influenced by the overall trends in the housebuilding market, non-residential construction sectors, as well as the levels of refurbishment and home improvement including niche market drivers such as the self-build and conservatory markets.

Growth in the pipes & fittings market in 2019 showed an increase of 9% since 2015. However, 2020 is proving to be a tough year for growth in all construction sectors. With the end of 2019 winter storms, many of which closed down some sites entirely. Brexit took up most of the start of 2020 continuing to cause top decision makers to waiver. The Covid-19 pandemic is continuing to cause issues throughout the country, even with the newest government advice on how to re-open businesses things remain uncertain.

Michelle Turner, Market Research Analyst at AMA Research, states "The short-term outlook for the UK pipes and fittings market remains weak, with construction output in 2020 likely to be heavily affected by delays caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and will be felt in some ways through until 2024; however as market trends look set to continue and projects are largely delayed as opposed to cancelled, forecasts are for output to be widely spread over the forecast period and remaining positive."

Plumbing pipe system products hold a larger share of the market versus Rainwater, Soil and Waste Products. However, with the increasing focus on green systems and eco-friendly solutions it will be interesting to see how this may change or even if it does.

It is worth noting that only two market leaders currently share 50% of the pipes & fittings market with the rest of the market being held by smaller companies. Builders merchants are the ones that dominate the distribution mix within the pipes & fittings market.
